Itinerary

Day 1

Arrive at Edinburgh airport / station and transfer to your hotel in Edinburgh with private chauffeur.

Day 2

Today you can enjoy " Hop on Hop off " city sightseeing tour of Edinburgh. Tour departs at Waverley Bridge (opposite rail station) and tour lasts approximately 1 hour, but ticket is valid for 24 hours. Hop on and off the bus to visit Edinburgh's attractions. Tour with taped commentary in English, French, Spanish, Italian and Dutch. You can enjoy some shopping in the many stores along Princes Street, including Jenners, one of the oldest department stores in the world. You can also visit the small museums and souvenir shops on the Royal Mile.

Day 3

Today take you to full day tour to Loch Lomond National Park and Stirling. 09:15 Minicoach depart from 207 High Street in Edinburgh and you will enjoy visit to the land of Scots heroes Rob Roy, Robert the Bruce and William Wallace, taking in the magnificent splendour of the medieval stronghold of Stirling Castle and the beautiful nature and forests of Scotland's first National Park and the remote north east side of the bonny, bonny bank of Loch Lomond. 18:00 Back to Edinburgh and return to your hotel for your final night in Edinburgh.

Sadly it's time to leave Edinburgh, transfer to the Edinburgh airport / station with private chauffeur to join your flight home.
